Applications Postmarked by March 31, 2018

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must be presently enrolled in their Senior year at a Mecklenburg County high school.
2. Applicants must reside in a single-parent household where the guardian annual income does not exceed the 200% threshold of the poverty rate (3rd column in the table) based on family size.

3. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
4. Applicants must be attending a North Carolina state supported college or university.

- The past three (3) years of income tax returns of your parent/guardian (i.e. IRS Form 1040).
- A copy of your FAFSA Award Letter. A copy of your FAFSA application will suffice to submit your application packet, however, selection is contingent upon receipt of your FAFSA Award Letter.

Please submit three (3) letters of recommendation, two from any high school faculty members and one personal or community member (non-family). Authors will write about how the applicant demonstrates initiative, integrity, and community involvement on a daily basis.
